THE HISTORY OF DENTISTRY

The First American Dentists

John Baker, who arrived from England in 1760, was the first dentist to practice in this country. Baker trained American patriot, Paul Revere, who used his training to cite the first forensic use of dentistry in this country. Revere made a positive identification of the body of revolutionary Major General Joseph Warren by identifying the two artificial teeth that he had set.

The first native-born American dentist, Isaac Greenwood, began practicing dentistry in 1779. John Greenwood, the son of Isaac Greenwood, was also a practicing dentist with a notable designation during the revolutionary war; he was George Washington's personal dentist. Greenwood was responsible for creating Washington's dentures which have been incorrectly classified as "wooden teeth".

These pioneers gave us the foundation for dentistry in this country. Fortunately, we live in an age where dentistry is practiced without some of the dangerous techniques our forefathers had to endure.
